

MUSC EMPLOYEE BLOOD/BODY FLUID EXPOSURE PROTOCOL

1. TREATMENT OF EXPOSURE

Open wounds: Soap, H₂O, & friction X5min

Mucous memb: Flush extensively with water X5-10min

2. REPORT THE EXPOSURE ASAP

Call 792-2991*

Employee Health Services (EHS) will fax Source Patient

Lab Requisition

Inform EHS if source is known HIV+

3. LABORATORY TESTING ON SOURCE COLLECTED ASAP

Draw 2 small or 1 lg gold top SST tube and

1 small lavender tube (no microtainers/bullets)

Affix patient label on lab request & specimen

Place in specimen bag with completed requisition

4. TRANSPORT/TUBE

Specimen to Children's Hospital Room 319 Specimen

Receiving (792-0707) OR Tube to #99

5. GO/FAX/SUBMIT

Go to EHS (57 Bee Street) OR Fax to 2-1200 OR
